Homework Expectations & Policies

As a school, we are committed to pursuing academic rigor in and outside of class. The role of homework is critical at Roosevelt Prep since it is either preparation for the next day of learning in class or it is practice for what was learned in day that class. We recognize that the amount of homework may be a new challenge for students but we encourage them all to lean into it rather than try to avoid it. The effort a student shows in attempting homework and turning it in on time for some credit is recognized and does influence ultimate grades. Additionally, the discipline of turning in homework, even if one is not confident or still has questions, is academically helpful since it impacts grades so heavily. Here are a few key principles that we want to remind you of as we end the quarter:

- 1. Homework will receive 50% credit if is it not turned in at the beginning of class until the next day.
- 2. Homework received after the second day that it was due will receive 0% credit.

3. Homework assignments that have been missed after the 2nd day will not be allowed to be made up for any credit.

The discipline or practice of doing and turning in homework is worth the effort at home from parents and students to ensure it is completed each night. Active homework participation helps the students academically but also from a grading perspective. We encourage you to remind your students not to get behind.

Lunch Delivery Policy

Effective NOW, the front office will NO LONGER accept food deliveries for students from restaurants/third-party vendors (ex. Jimmy John's, Door Dash, etc.). Please note any outside food will not be accepted and your scholar will receive an emergency lunch for that day. Students should bring a lunch from home or order ahead from our PSO-sponsored lunch program My Hot Lunch Box. If a student forgets lunch, a parent may bring it to the lunch cart in the front office before 10am and the student will be notified. For lunches arriving after 10am, it is the student's responsibility to collect it from the office during their lunch period or after-school. Class time will not be interrupted for lunch delivery.
