November 27<sup>th</sup> we will begin our new Aces Powerlifting Club. This will be open to all boys and girls in grades 6-9. If you play one sport, you are strongly encouraged to be involved in this program. Students will learn the proper technique for age-appropriate lifting in age-appropriate ways. Students will become faster and stronger.

**Practice Location: Roosevelt Prep Weight Room**

**Practice Dates/Time: Monday, Tuesday, Friday/3:30-4:45pm**

The fee is \$150 for 8 weeks of weight room programming where kids will learn the fundamentals of strength training, technique, and explosiveness. The fee will provide access to the Aces weightroom, weight room etiquette, programming by Coach Pham (professional

powerlifter and coach), and an Aces Powerlifting t-shirt that indicates their involvement in the club that they will get to keep at the end of their season.

This will help school culture within our athletic program and help our athletes become stronger and faster. For your child to have success over their opponent they have to put in the work in the off season or else they will have a challenging time being successful. Individually we must build the athlete for the better of the team. This starts with you!!!! If you are not currently involved in the sports program, this is a great way to become involved and to better yourself physically and mentally.

Students will then be picked up in the back of the school by the north gate.

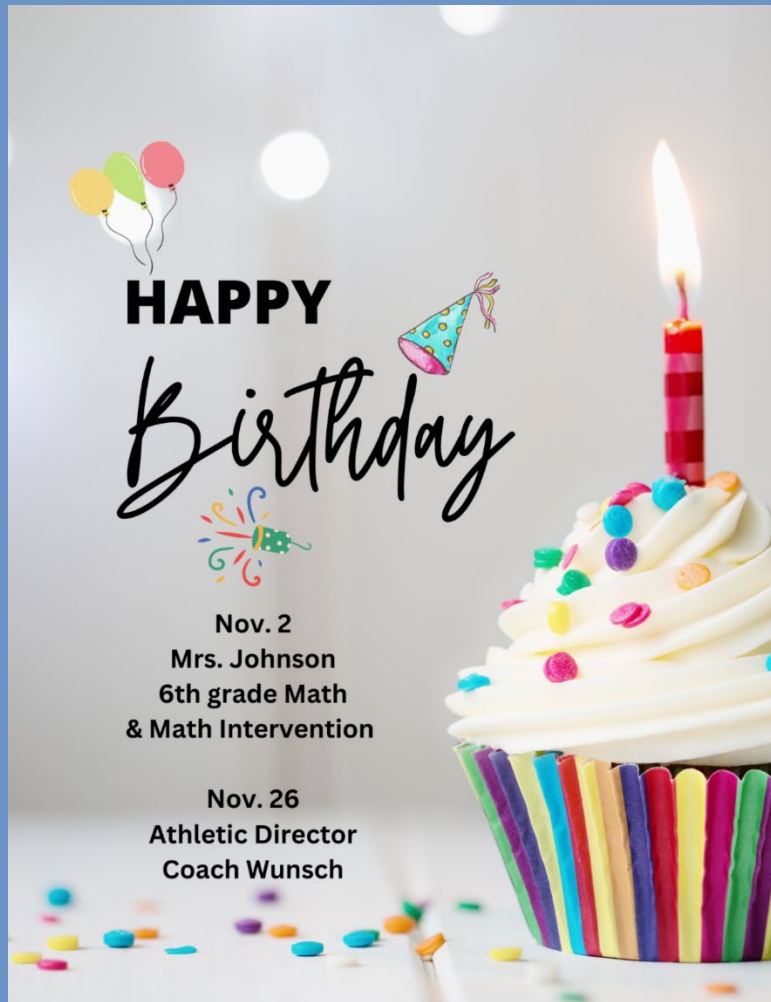

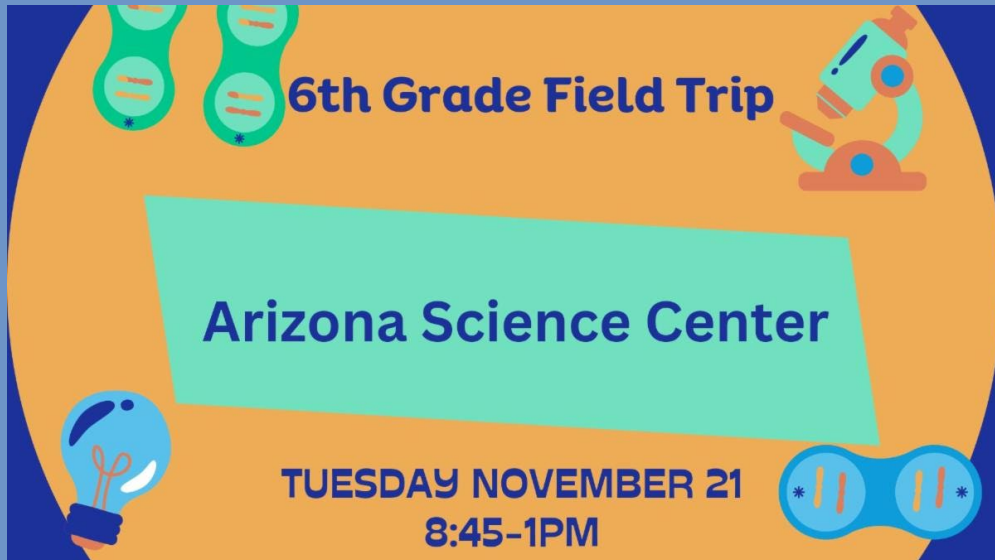

# Lunch Policy!

Effective NOW, the front office will NO LONGER accept food deliveries for students from restaurants/third-party vendors (ex. Jimmy John's, Door Dash, etc.).
