Tardy Policy

Clarification Point 1: Classroom instruction begins daily at 7:50am for Archway (K-5th) and 8:00am for our Preparatory (6th - 9th) scholars. We strive every day to help our students learn the importance of timeliness and responsibility and in this we ask for your partnership in helping students be at school daily, on time and ready to learn.

Clarification Point 2: Students will need to report to the front office to be allowed on campus if they arrive when classroom instruction has already begun.

Archway (K-5th) Students: Parents must be physically present to sign scholars in if they arrive on campus after classroom instruction begins. **No drops offs allowed.**

Preparatory (6th - 9th) Students: Students must sign themselves in at the computers located in the lobby as you enter the front door. They will need to take the pass printed for them to their classroom.

Clarification Point 3: Prep students can not, and will not be allowed to, sign in their Archway student. Archway students will remain in the front office until a parent/guardian is reached to sign them in.

Lunch Policy!

Effective NOW, the front office will NO LONGER accept food deliveries for students from restaurants/third-party vendors (ex. Jimmy John's, Door Dash, etc.). Please note any outside food will not be accepted and your scholar will receive an emergency lunch for that day. Students should bring a lunch from home or order ahead from our PSO-sponsored lunch program My Hot Lunch Box. If a student forgets lunch, a parent may bring it to the lunch cart in the front office before 10am and the student will be notified. For lunches arriving after 10am, it is the student's responsibility to collect it from the office during their lunch period or after-school. Class time will not be interrupted for lunch delivery.
